Otama Marere Discretionary Grants are available to assist with costs associated for Kaupapa Māori, cultural pursuits and whānau activities of a registered shareholder or a beneficiary of a whānau trust in Otama Marere who can demonstrate a need or hardship. The amount of the Discretionary grant is up to \$1,000.00. The Trustees reserve the right to suspend or vary the amount of the grant, dependant on the financial position and commitments of the Trust.

Discretionary Grant Policy and Criteria

- 1. Discretionary Grant applications will only be accepted if the applicant meets the following criteria:
 - (a) there is no age criteria for registered shareholder of Otama Marere or a beneficiary of a whānau trust that is a shareholder in Otama Marere;
 - (b) the Applicant has accurately and completely filled in the application form;
 - (c) the Applicant has provided all requested supporting documents; and
 - (d) there are no retrospective applications; ie invoices have to be less than three (3) months old.
- 2. Discretionary Grants may be paid to a health provider (as decided by the trustees) or to an organisation/ organising committee on production of information to the satisfaction of the trustees.
