Otama Marere Trust Discretionary Grant Policy

RATIONALE:

This policy sets guidelines for the consideration of a Discretionary Grant to be paid out of allocated funds for owners and their beneficiaries who can demonstrate a need or hardship that the Trust is minded to support for Kaupapa Māori, cultural pursuits and whānau activities.

2. GUIDELINES:

- The trust will make available a grant of up to \$1,000 per application to assist with
 - Representative Kapahaka;
 - Hui-a-Whānau;
 - Whānau Reunions;
 - Hura kohatu;
- There is no age criteria for this grant;
- Retrospective grants will not be considered, i.e invoices have to be less than 3 months old and events need to be held at a future date.

3. GRANTS:

 a) Payment of a Discretionary Grant is subject to approval by the Trustees and will be on the basis of need or hardship via invoice or other proof of purchase/representation;

b) Certified Account Name and Account Number:

Each applicant must provide a certified copy of a bank statement or ATM printout which clearly displays the applicants name and bank account number. Any copy needs to be certified by the applicant's bank, a Justice of the Peace, New Zealand Lawyer, Chartered Accountant, Notary Public, New Zealand Honorary Consul or authorised employee of Perpetual Guardian. An application will not be complete until this has been provided.
